

TSS Dressage Shows

General

- A. Host Farm will have an established website for advertising shows, judges, ride times and results
 - 1. Host Farm will send all information regarding shows to TSS Marketing Coordinator to advertise on TSS Facebook page, Web page and gmail to members.
- B. Host Farm will conduct all shows using USEF or WDAA rules
- C. L judges or above to be used at shows
- D. Entry fees will be in agreement with all other Triangle Dressage shows
- E. Host Farm will be responsible for \$200 in sponsorship at the beginning of the year.
(see sponsorship form)

Host Farm Will Offer

- A. Formal large (20 x 60 meters or 66' x 198'), clearly marked arena with good footing
- B. Warm-up area that is separate from formal ring
 - 1. If warm-up ring is not provided, upon agreement of judge the host farm will hold scheduled "schooling breaks" of 5 minutes for specified number of riders.
- C. Classes for Introductory, Training and First+ and Musical Freestyle class levels plus Western dressage are required.
 - 1. *Junior, Adult Amateur, Masters and Open divisions*
 - 2. Host Farm reserves the right to hold additional classes
- D. Adequate parking facilities
- E. Adequate bathroom facilities
- F. Water for horses

Prior to Show

- A. Host Farm must provide an entry form on their website for entries
- B. Host Farm will contact TSS marketing coordinator with name of judge and any other information they would like posted in an email to TSS members, TSS Facebook page and TSS website
- C. Host Farm will list ride order no later than 2 days prior to the show on their website/FB page.
- D. Host Farm will list all scores for the show on their website and send to TSS marketing coordinator no later than 5 days after the show for publication by TSS

Shows

- A. Host Farm will announce dates no later than the yearly banquet.
- B. Host Farm will provide ring stewards, scorer, secretary, runner and judge plus any needed volunteers
- C. Breaks will be determined by show manager

D. Ribbons and awards will be provided and paid for by Host Farm and displayed during the show

1. Modified Danish System to be used for ribbons

a. Suggested test scoring:

67% & above – First (blue)

62% - 66.99% - Second (red)

57% - 61.99% - Third (yellow)

52% - 56.99% - Fourth (white)

47% - 51.99% - Fifth (pink)

46% and below – Sixth (green)

E. Ride times will be posted on a board for general viewing the day of the show with scores added as ridden.

F. No later than 30 minutes after ride is completed, ribbons/tests will be placed in an area for rider pick-up

Year-End Awards

A. Ribbons for the Dressage winners are provided by TSS

B. Awards for the Champion, Reserve Champion, third, fourth, fifth and sixth place winners are selected and provided by the Hosting Farms at the end of the season.

C. Divisions for prizes will be Junior/ YR (21 & under), AA (22-59), Masters (60-74) Platinum (75+)
