

Triangle Show Series Jumpers Shows

- A. Host Farm will have an established website for advertising shows.
 - 1. Host Farm will send all information regarding shows to TSS Marketing Coordinator to advertise on TSS Facebook page, Web page and gmail to members.
- B. Host Farm will conduct all shows using USEF
- C. Entry fees will be in agreement with other Triangle Farms
- D. Host Farm is responsible for \$200 in sponsorship at the beginning of the year. (See sponsorship form)

Host Farm Will Offer

- A. Formal large arena with good footing
- B. Offer a separate warm up ring and/or allow one or two warm up fences in the main arena during fence height change between divisions
- C. Suitable safe jumps
- D. Adequate parking facilities
- E. Adequate bathroom facilities
- F. Water for horses

Shows

- A. Host Farm will announce dates no later than yearly banquet
- B. Host Farms will provide ring stewards, announcer, secretary, jump crew and judge plus any needed volunteers
- C. Jumper classes must coordinate with TSS Year-End Division/Awards

Prior to Show

- A. Host Farm will contact TSS Marketing Coordinator with name of judge and any other information they would like posted in an email to TSS members, TSS Facebook page and TSS website
 - 1. Volunteers will be assigned no more than 2 jobs per show
- B. Ribbons and awards will be provided and paid for by host farm and displayed during show
 - 1. Ribbons awarded to sixth place
 - 2. Champion and Reserve Champion awarded for each division

Day of Show

- A. If there are post-entries the day of the show riders wishing to join the TSS series will be required to fill out a Membership Form on the website for accurate information and use paypal for payment to ensure proper accounting purposes. Points to accrue only after membership/payment are complete.

B. When show is complete, the Champion/Reserve **EXCEL** form provided by the Marketing Coordinator must be completed and sent to the TSS gmail account **no later than 5** days after the show. TSS Market Coordinator will post the results on the TSS webpage.

Year-End Awards:

- A. Ribbons for the Jumpers winners are provided by TSS
- B. Champion and Reserve Champion plus any additional prizes are awarded and selected by points earned and calculated during a member's current year. The cost of the awards **and** any engraving/embroidery is the responsibility of the hosting farms and is divided equally among them.
